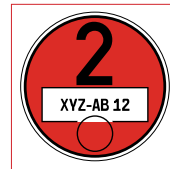
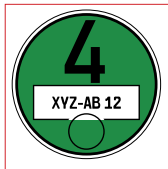
Fine Particle Stickers will be required

On March 1st, 2008 the city of Mannheim Mannheim will introduce an environmental zone in the city centre. The Congress Centre Rosengarten is located in the city centre.

The following applies for Diesel Motor and Otto Engine Vehicles:

Euro 4 oder green sticker,
Euro 3 oder yellow sticker und
Euro 2 oder red sticker.

Vehicles with a categorization poorer than
Euro 1 **will not** obtain any sticker.



1. **Where to get the Fine Particle Stickers from?**
 - From the central vehicle registration office
 - From the citizen's services
 - From the technical control board, from Dekra or any garage being authorized for exhaust emission tests.

2. **Charges for the Fine Particle Sticker**
5. - Euro

3. **How to find out which Sticker a Car will get?**
The last two figures of the emission code number are decisive for the sticker that a vehicle will get.
The emission code number (emission standard) is indicated on the vehicle registration certificate. It is therefore required to bring in this document when applying for the sticker.
It is not necessary to get the sticker in Mannheim. It can be obtained from any central registration office in your city.

4. **Period of Validity for the Different Stickers?**
Green (Euro 4) und yellow (Euro 3) stickers stickers are valid for an unlimited period.
Red (Euro 2) stickers are valid until December 31, 2011
5. **What happens upon being "caught" driving without the Sticker?**
40,- Euro will be charged and a point in the register at the Federal Motor Authority in Flensburg will be assigned.

6. **Are there Exceptions?**
A general disposition rules possible exceptions. If you can prove that your car cannot be retrofitted, a certificate of exemption can be established for a year.
